## Computing : Ms Parkes

**Our Learning:** In the first term Year 8 students study HTML, AI, and Machine Learning would explore diverse aspects of computer science. In learning HTML, they understand how to structure and design web content using tags for text, images, and multimedia, integrating CSS for visual styling. Their study of Artificial Intelligence involved examining how machines can mimic human cognitive processes, such as problem-solving, learning, and reasoning. Delving into Machine Learning, they focused on creating and training algorithms to analyse data, recognise patterns, and improve task performance over time without explicit programming. Through these studies, the student gain insights into web development fundamentals and cutting-edge technologies shaping automation and intelligent systems.

Students have also developed their skills in working within the Cartesian plane, representing data, and using tables and probability to solve problems. Overall, they are building a strong foundation in these areas, which will support their continued success in future mathematical topics

## Music : Mr Larsen

**Our Learning:** In Term 1A, Year 8 students have been developing their keyboard skills through learning several Romantic Period repertoire. They have explored some key features of Music in the Romantic Period including the Waltz and Songs without Words. In Term 1B, students have been developing their ensemble performance and composition skills in the Programme Music Unit. They performed Mars from The Planets by Holst, and composed a Programme Music piece based on the idea of the planet Venus.

## Physical Education : Mr Sheridan

Target: E

**Our Learning:** This academic year students started with Touch Rugby, which allowed us to group students throughout the different year groups. From these groups, students will develop their movement and skills through the following activities on land: Basketball, Volleyball, Athletics, Striking and Fielding, Net and Wall, Movement analysis thorough HRF. Students will develop knowledge and understanding further with water based swimming and Personal Survival activities.
